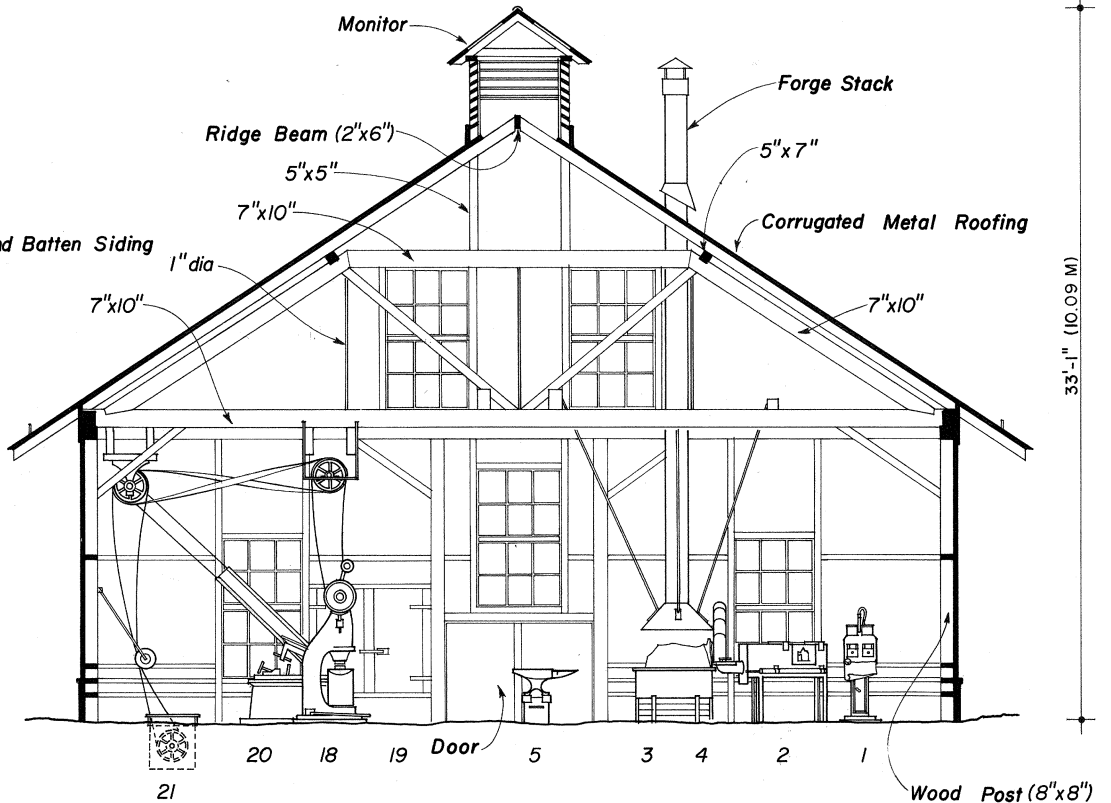


SECTION A-A

BUILDING MATERIALS

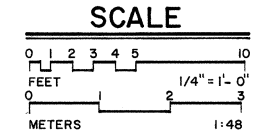
- Roof - Wood roof trusses and corrugated metal roofing
